# Attention 6<sup>th</sup> grade parents:

As your student prepares to enter 7<sup>th</sup> grade, it is important to know there are immunization requirements prior to the first day of school. In Ohio it is required to have a booster dose of Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) and the Meningococcal vaccine prior the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school.

Now is the time to check with your medical provider to see if your child has had these vaccines. Copies of the written record from your child's immunization provider can be brought to the Jr High before attending the first day of the 2022-23 school year. 
#### \_House Board Game Competitions
